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Transitional Provision for the Limitation of the Working Life Dose

Recommendation of the German Commission on Radiological Protection

Adopted at the 82nd session of the Commission on Radiological Protection on March 28, 1988

**In the event of any doubts about the meaning,
the German original as published shall prevail.**

With respect to the inclusion of its recommendation of December 11, 1987, into the amendment to the Radiological Protection Ordinance, the Commission on Radiological Protection considers it an adequate approach to include a transitional provision for a limited period of time when introducing a limitation of the dose admissible during an individual's working life. For this purpose, the Commission suggests the following regulation:

“Occupationally exposed persons whose effective dose has already exceeded, or will exceed until December 31, 1995, 400 mSv, may continue to work in the controlled access area provided their dose per calendar year does not exceed 10 mSv. These persons shall be reported to the authority and shall be subjected to the same annual medical checkup as Class A persons.”
